Timothy Albrecht is Professor of Music and University Organist at Emory University in Atlanta, where he heads the graduate organ degree program. He concertizes extensively and gives masterclasses throughout the United States and Europe. Born in Minneapolis, Timothy Albrecht moved to Los Angeles and Milwaukee, where he first studied piano with east-European emigrant, Eugenia Prekosh. He earned two undergraduate degrees from Oberlin and his doctorate from the Eastman School of Music. Currently Augsburg Fortress

publishes eleven volumes of his hymn-based organ compositions entitled Grace Notes,Volumes I-XI.

Fishburne is the building directly between Glenn Memorial UMC, 1660 N. 




