# St. Alban's Winner Johannes Unger Plays March 11 at PRUMC

Johannes Unger, born in Schlema (Erzgebirge, East Germany) in 1976, was influenced in his early life by his musical parents. He received a complete musical training in the Spezialschule fur Musik in Halle, going on to study further at the Felix Mendelssohn Bartholdy Academy for

Music and Theatre in Leipzig. He studied organ with Ullrich Bohme, organist of the famous St. Thomas Church in Leipzig, and piano with Markus Tomas. Since 1999 he has been studying in the solo class of Hans Fagius in Copenhagen.

In 2001 he took top honors at the 21<sup>st</sup> biennial St. Albans International Organ Competition. The previous year he won the 12<sup>th</sup> International J.S. Bach Competition in Leipzig, and in 1998 he wont he first prize at the Organ Competition in Odense, Denmark, where he was the youngest participant.

He has performed in Germany, France, Denmark, Australia and the United States. His first solo CD, released in 2000, was recorded on the Silbermann organ in Rotha, near Leipzig. Johannes Unger Recital



#### Blanche Boyter Threatte 1909-2003

Blanche Threatte was Minister of Music and Organist at Morningside Baptist Church for thirty-four years. She was the first elementary music specialist in the Atlanta Public Schools, and organized the first boys' choir in APS. When the school system was split into areas in the 1950's, she was Music Resource Teacher in Area II (southwest Atlanta) until her retirement in 1973. She was a graduate of Converse College and Appalachian State Teachers' College. She was state president of Delta Kappa Gamma and was active in the Thursday Morning Music Club.


