### Franck Celebration David Coucheron, violin; Julie Coucheron, piano; Jens Korndörfer, organ


Sonata in A major for piano and violin Trois Chorals for organ

Composer, organist, and pianist César-Auguste Jean-Guillaume Hubert Franck (1822-1890) is one of the giants of the Romantic era. This child-prodigy entered the Liège Conservatory at age 8 and gave his first concert at 12, with the king of Belgium in the audience! Later he was appointed professor at the Paris Conservatory and organist at the Basilique St. Clotilde, where he was famous for his stunning improvisations.

Franck's music is full of sweeping melodies, dramatic outbursts, and romantic longing. Join us in a celebration of the 200th birthday of this magician of sound!

This event will end our 2022 events, but we still have 2023 around the corner. We have some very exciting events happing throughout the rest of our AGO Program Season, so please stay tuned!


